

Policy BD-114 Recognition of Committees

PURPOSE:

It is the policy of the Pennsylvania Trauma Systems Foundation (PTSF) to identify criteria for committees to meet in order to be formally recognized and supported by the board of directors.

PROCEDURE:

In order to request formal, board recognition, committees must . . .

- Develop a written charter that includes how the committee will both further and enhance the PTSF's mission and vision.
- 2. Provide a current membership roster that shows statewide membership from accredited trauma centers.
- 3. Show active committee involvement for at least one year.
- 4. Show evidence of an engaged Community on the PTSF website.
- 5. Provide evidence of a defined work plan, as well as goals achieved within the past 12-months.

NOTE: During this time of committee organization, PTSF will support the committee with conference call/WebEx capabilities.

Once approved, board recognized committees will . . .

- 1. Be added to the Bylaws.
- 2. Adhere to the guidelines outlined in <u>BD-109 Committee Membership</u>.

Additional considerations . . .

Approved by PTSF Board of Directors:

- Compliance with this policy does not automatically guarantee board approval.
- 2. Board support of a committee can be revoked at any time.
