A knowledge of PTSF software and data analysis will be essential to guide the ongoing development of PTSF's central PI database and provide analytical expertise on PI initiatives.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

The PTSF Manager of Trauma Performance Improvement is the statewide resource and expert in trauma Performance Improvement (PI). Key facets of the position include:

- Overseeing organization-wide efforts to implement and evaluate a data-driven trauma PI program throughout Pennsylvania.
- Facilitating hospital based and statewide performance improvement activities and works with partner organizations to use multiple sources of data to advance quality, timeliness, and efficiency of care for injured patients.
- Assisting with orienting and educating trauma PI professionals at trauma centers and hospitals pursuing trauma accreditation throughout the state to PTSF software and trauma PI.
- Guiding the PA Trauma Quality Improvement Program (PA-TQIP) in collaboration with PTSF staff and trauma leadership throughout the Commonwealth.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Nursing
- A minimum of three years clinical experience and two years performance improvement experience
- Availability for overnight, work-related travel, as needed, 10-15% of the time
- Valid driver's license

Preferred Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Nursing, Epidemiology, Health Care Administration, Public Health, or related field
- Working knowledge/familiarity with COLLECTOR™ Trauma Registry and Outcomes™ software
- Completion of the Society of Trauma Nurses (STN) Trauma Outcomes & Performance Improvement Course (TOPIC)
